1 . All-China Journalists' Association

All-China Journalists Association (ACJA) is a national non-governmental organization of China's press circle. Its predecessor, China Journalists Society, was established in November 8, 1937, which is the Journalists Day of China.

As a national non-governmental organization, ACJA has 200 members (not individual ones) including 156 national media like Xinhua News Agency, the People's Daily, Guangming Daily, Economic Daily, CCTV, China National Radio, etc., 32 province-level journalists associations, 30 national professional journalists associations and 100 institutions engaged in journalism education and research, covering the press related people (nearly 1 million) in China.

The supreme decision-making body of ACJA is Board of Directors, which serves five years in each term. The Board, elected by the group of members, consists of heads of media organizations, press elite and outstanding editors, reporters and program hosts. The Chairman and Vice Chairman are elected by the Standing Committee of the Board. The Secretary General is appointed also by the Standing Committee of the Board, is in charge of the association's daily affairs.

ACJA has the Domestic Work Department, the International Work Department, the Office for Taiwan, Hong Kong and Macao Affairs

Internet Center, the Training and Research Center, and the Office.

The highest news and journalists Awards in China, China News and Changjiang Taofen (the two people, named Mr. Fan Chang, Mr. Zou Taofen, are most outstanding reporter and editor in China history) Awards are held by ACJA. Professional Self-legitimate rights safeguarding, training, research as well as t with other countries are main functions of ACJA.

ACJA has so far, in various forms, established exchanges and co with many foreign journalists associations and press organizations.

2. *Publicity Department of the CPC Central Committee*

Publicity Department of the CPC Central Committee is an department of the Central Committee of Communist Party which is mainly in charge of guiding theoretical study, public research; organizing and coordinating important news reports; ethical construction and spiritual civilization building; coordinating promoting cultural reform; planning the training of human resources in press and culture circles.

Publicity Department of the CPC Central Committee was established in July 1921 when Communist Party of China was founded.

The Minister of the Publicity Department of the CPC Central C

is Mr. Liu Qibao, the member of the Political Bureau of the Committee of CPC and the member of the Secretariat of the Committee of CPC.

The Nature and Guiding Ideology of the Communist Party of

The Communist Party of China (CPC) is the vanguard of the working class, the faithful representative of the interests of the people of all ethnic groups, and the core of leadership of the socialist cause.

After the People's Republic of China was founded in 1949, it became the ruling party, leading the country in its political life and activities. The leadership of the CPC over state affairs focuses on principles, political orientation, decision making on major issues, makes recommendations regarding the appointment of important officials to government bodies. Within the system of the state leadership, the Party cannot replace the functions and powers of the bodies of state power. What are subject to the discretion of the National People's Congress and its Standing Committee should be submitted as Party's proposals, and submitted through government to the NPC and its Standing Committee for a decision according to the law. In this way the Party's proposals

are changed into the state will and become the codes of conduct observed by the whole society. The Party has to act within the the Constitution and laws, guaranteeing that the legislative, judicial, administrative departments of the state as well as economic, cultural, mass organizations work in an active, independent, responsible, coordinated manner.

3. Guangming Daily

Guangming Daily was established on June 16, 1949. It is a national comprehensive daily newspaper with long history and unique characteristics. Guangming Daily is based in Beijing, having 36 reporter stations in China and more than 20 reporter stations around the world.

Guangming Daily has a large number of readers in every social stratum in China, especially in the intellectual circles. It is called the “the homeland of intellectuals”. The content of this newspaper covers politics, economics, technology, culture, theory, military, legal issues. Guangming Daily now has 800 employees involving editing, printing, and advertisement promoting.

4. China News Service

China News Service (CNS) is not only a state-level news agency spreading news worldwide, but also an international news agency.

Liao Chengzhi, former vice chairman of the Standing Committee of the National People's Congress, was the founder and leader of CNS. In addition to him, there were other major sponsors and builders, such as Jin Zhonghua, Hu Yuzhi, and Hong Sisi. Jin Zhonghua, a well-known expert on international issues, was the first president of CNS. In its early form, CNS was the International News Service, established by Wang Changjiang and Hu Yuzhi in 1938.

CNS functions as a state-level news agency spreading news worldwide and maintaining a database of information from global Chinese-language media. It is an international news agency. It fulfills its responsibility through traditional and modern style reports (including writings, photos and special articles) and a modern method of reporting (mainly through internet, videos and audio). It is provided to overseas Chinese-language newspapers and independent media, as well as newspapers and journals.

There are presently more than 1000 employees at CNS, with its headquarters in Beijing. It has 28 branches in China, Hong Kong, Macao, as well as branches or report stations in Tokyo, Bangkok, Singapore, Lumpur, New York, Washington, Los Angeles, San Francisco, Vancouver, London, Paris, Sydney and Moscow. It also has reporters in Taipei.

Based on a multi-channel, multi-level and multi-function news system, CNS provides all kinds of news and information, 24 hours.

CNS's clients and cooperative partners are spread throughout the world.

As a Chinese-language media source, CNS was an Asian pioneer. It was the first to set up its internet portal. The website www.chinanews.com.cn

was launched in Hong Kong in 1995. On January 1, 1999, the headquarters

in Beijing launched its official website, named China News Center

(www.chinanews.com.cn). Chinanews is considered one of China's

most important online news sources.

5.Xinjiang Economic Daily

Xinjiang Economic Daily was established in the year of 1991, and is

6. Qinghai Journalists Association

Qinghai Journalists Association is established in the year of 1992, a province-level non-governmental organization in Qinghai Autonomous Region composed of 90 media, covering 5000 journalists.

The main functions of the association are: organizing annual newsmen congress, carrying on professional training and self-discipline, safeguarding journalists' legitimate rights, organizing lectures and seminars, organizing group visits, etc.
